APPOINTMENT OF INDEPENDENT GOVERNORS

TIME COMMITMENT	Normally, between four and six scheduled Board meetings and one or two Board strategy days a year. Additional Board meetings may be called where necessary. Other committee meetings as necessary. In particular Independent Governors are usually asked to serve on other committees in the University, either as chair or as a member. Most committees meet between 3 to 4 times a year. Some additional time will be required to study papers, attend University events and other engagements. The likely total time commitment is between half a day and one day per month, plus an additional 1-2 days in the Governor's first year for induction. Service as a chair of a committee, or as Vice-Chair or Chair of the Board, will require a significant additional commitment.
LOCATION OF	Meetings take place at the University's Holloway Road & Aldgate
MEETINGS:	campuses (currently remotely via MS Teams). Meeting paperwork is provided in electronic format.
REMUNERATION	Governors are not salaried, but reasonable expenses are paid.
DURATION OF	Three years with the possibility of renewal, up to a maximum
APPOINTMENT	(normally) of nine years' continuous service.
OBJECT OF THE	The University's Object is to advance education (including
UNIVERSITY	industrial, commercial, professional and scientific training) for the benefit of the public by carrying on, conducting and developing a university and by promoting teaching and research.
SPECIFIC QUALITIES AND SKILLS SOUGHT	 The appointee should demonstrate experience of working at board level, preferably in a large, complex organisation and/or with a high degree of regulation; The appointee should demonstrate commitment to the Object of the University and to have the ability to contribute effectively to future policy and strategy developments; The appointee must demonstrate a commitment to working as part of a team and possess excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
