An Aurora Partnership

In 2023, Aurora partnered with Medibank to create the new mental health model iMH.

In 2023, Aurora partnered with Medibank Private to introduce a new model of private mental health care.

The model focuses on providing flexible care pathways including a range of out-of-hospital services such as in-home care and telehealth, as well as care coordination which runs across all services both inpatient and community.

The iMH hospitals offer these services with no additional costs for patients with eligible private health insurance, apart from any excess or co-payment that would normally apply. These services are typically not included under a traditional psychiatric model of care in the private system.


Aimed at providing greater access, choice and flexibility to mental health services, the 50/50 joint venture, known as iMH, will initially invest \$31 million into three hospitals delivering a combined 153 new mental health beds and comprehensive out-of-hospital support.

The partnership will draw on Aurora
Healthcare's established mental health
expertise and the combined experience of
both Aurora Healthcare and Medibank's
Amplar Health business in introducing
innovative models of care across Australia.

Aurora Healthcare will contribute two hospitals in New South Wales and the Australian Capital Territory to iMH, with its Hirondelle Private Hospital in Chatswood to be converted into a 45-bed mental health facility, while Deakin Private Hospital in Canberra which opened in March 2023 features 52 beds, including the city's first dedicated private adolescent and young adult unit.

The joint venture will invest in a new specially designed 56-bed mental health facility to be built in Alexandria, New South Wales.

There are four high-priority locations earmarked in the next 24 months for acquisition to further iMH's footprint.



iMH is providing an innovative model of private mental health care. It will complement Aurora Healthcare private mental health hospitals and expand the variety of services that we offer.

Aurora Healthcare and Amplar Health share a vision to make private mental health services nationally accessible. In 2023 Aurora Healthcare and Amplar Health launched iMH's flagship private mental health hospital, Deakin Private Hospital.

The service model underpinning iMH is focused on preventing avoidable hospital admissions and readmissions whilst supporting the patients' recovery in the longer term through a range of innovative community based services which can be tailored to the patients needs.

iMH proudly provides mental health treatment and services for for patients across the age spectrum from adolescents to older persons.

Key specialty areas of focus include mood disorders, adolescent and adult mental health, addictive disorders, personality disorders and anxiety disorders.

The cornerstones of our success are the result of:

- Psychiatrist-led treatment plans tailored to patient needs and goals
- · Variety and breadth in treatment options inside and outside of the hospital

- · Disciplined expansion and acquisition of healthcare facilities in communities with long term demand

Care pathways and treatment options

Our new model of care offers tailored and flexible approaches to in-hospital and in-home mental health care. Treatment recommendations are in consultation with the treating psychiatrist. Our care pathways can be accessed directly, there is no requirement for an inpatient admission to access.

Our patients receive the right level of care at the right time – from overnight hospital stays, day hospital attendance including group therapy, to community-based treatment including telehealth and mental health support in the home.

Care coordination

Care coordinators will be on staff to ensure that admitted patients smoothly transition between inpatient, outpatient and community settings, and to support patients during the post-discharge period.

Admissions coordination

Admission and Assessment Coordinators with local hospital knowledge provide preadmission screening and risk assessment for potential patients and will liaise with admitting specialists to confirm patient service eligibility and an admission.

Overnight admissions

The length of an overnight admission will be determined by the treating psychiatrist and in consultation with each patient.

Day programs and inpatient groups

A range of evidence-based specialty day programs will be available to patients, as well as a tailored inpatient group program with both set and elective modules that patients can opt-in to attend

Intensive Day Hospital

Providing a tailored experience for patients through both individual and group therapy.

Community care

Community care can be used as an alternative to overnight admissions, as a part of a patient's discharge plan or used in conjunction with day programs.

Extended post discharge follow up

Undertaken by the Care Coordinators who have worked closely with patients across their care continuum providing ongoing support for up to 12 weeks post discharge.
